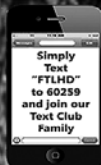

At the upcoming April 17th Chapter meeting the election process for Executive Board and Trustees begins with nominations for these positions. At the May 15th meeting nominations will also be accepted and the process ends with the elections taking place at the June 19th meeting. Please come out and support our election process. We need members to step up and hold positions and keep our Chapter growing and supporting our mission of motorcycle safety and biker rights. We need at least four individuals to hold the Executive Board positions (president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer) in order to keep our Chapter open. I want everyone to know that it has been an honor to serve as your Chapter President this past year. To make it official, after my term of office ends on June 19th, I will be unable to accept the nomination for President or any other Board or Trustee position for the next year.

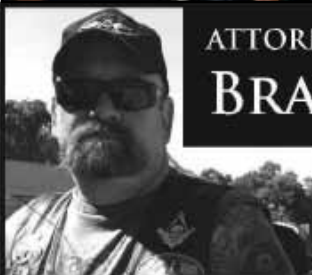

Southeast Chapter Meeting Minutes Mar 20, 2016

Sergeant at Arms Steve “Nighthawk” Chomiak called the meeting to order at 10:17 am. There were 20 members and 2 guests in attendance. The meeting started following the Pledge of Allegiance, moment of silence and a prayer by Poppi.

President’s Report: Frank thanked everyone for coming to the Davie Moose Lodge for the meeting. Since our last meeting the Chapter has had one member injured and another killed in traffic accidents. Daniel “Airborne” Ortnier (States MC) was injured and on the mend. Glenn “Swede” Malmstrom was an active American Legion Post 222 rider and life member of ABATE, who succumbed to his injuries. Please keep both of those guys and their families in your prayers.

Each ABATE member has a \$4000.00 Death and Dismemberment Insurance Policy as part of your membership dues. Please fill out the insurance beneficiary card which determines where the insurance payment goes, if something happens to you (God forbid) and you do not have a beneficiary listed, the money goes into probate for your estate, which will take longer to receive the money. If you need a new beneficiary card please contact our Membership Trustee T-Man.

I received a message from Joel and Kathy Honeycutt, our Products Trustees. They had decided to move to their other home near Lake City; they actually pulled out of town the day before today’s meeting. They did an outstanding job for the Chapter and will be greatly missed.

This year ABATE did not have any success in the

Florida State Legislation. The proposed \$300,000 ABATE Safety Money was hacked in the Senate before going to the Governor for signature (where the Governor vetoed it last year). Additionally, the Vulnerable Road User’s Bill (Stiffer Penalties) passed all committees but “died” on the table in the Senate, never getting a vote.

The State has asked the Chapters to consider three amendments for annual and life dues. The floor was opened for discussion. **Paraphrased Amendment #1:** \$20 annual and \$600 life membership; Chapter’s give the State Treasury \$10 for each annual and \$400 for life membership. **Paraphrased Amendment #2:** \$20 annual and \$150 life membership; Chapter’s give the State Treasury \$20 for each annual and \$150 for life membership (all membership revenue goes to the State Treasury). **Paraphrased Amendment #3:** \$30 annual and \$300 life membership; Chapter’s give the State Treasury \$20 for each annual and \$300 for life membership. Chapter members in attendance voted unanimously in support for Amendment #3.

A reminder that the Southeast Chapter elections for Executive Board and Trustee positions will begin with nominations in the months of April and May with the election taking place at the June meeting. Last year, we had difficulty filling the four required positions in order to continue as a Chapter; those positions are president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer. If Chapter members are not willing to step-up, the State ABATE office will attempt to find within our Chapter’s 500+ members four individuals willing to fill each of these positions. If unable to do so, the State will close the Chapter and the membership will become at-large members and the

Chapter's assets will be returned to the State office. I encourage anyone wanting to be on the Executive Board or hold a Trustee position to speak-up, step-up, and run for a position.

Vice-President's Report: Poppi thanked everyone for coming and encouraged everyone to come out and support the Southeast Chapter Elections. You can nominate someone or even yourself to any position that you might want. We are having great riding weather and please watch out for cages. Additionally, Southeast Chapter member Papa Harley is sick, was placed in hospice, but now has returned home. Please keep him in your prayers.

Secretary's Report: (Marie was excused. She is very sick and at home. Please pray for a quick recovery.) A motion was made to accept the minutes as printed, seconded, and no discussion. Motion was passed. (A special thanks to Joanne "Crittter" Napoli for stepping up and taking the minutes for today's meeting.)

Treasurer's Report: T-Man read the financial report for February. A motion was made to accept the financial report, seconded, all were in favor, and the Motion was passed. T-Man said 41 members had to be refunded \$10 for over payment of the dues. The Chapter presented a \$1,000.00 donation to the State Treasury at the February meeting. Also the Chapter gave an additional \$300.00 to support the State sponsored drawing tickets.

Sergeant at Arms' Report: Steve thanked everyone for coming today. He reminded everyone that tomorrow is the beginning of spring break at our local school districts, but there is still a lot of schools open for sports, etc. Please be careful near our schools.

Road Captain's Report: Gambler was excused. Poppi spoke about the last ride to Mickey's. It was a good ride but all the road rules are not being followed, especially changing lanes. We need to follow basic road rules and that Gambler should put them in the next newsletter.

Safety Director's Report: Frank spoke in place of

Gambler. He mentioned that we had a Safety booth at a 4X4 event on March 12th in Miami Gardens. They signed up a new ABATE member and collected \$11.00 safety donation. Gambler wanted to remind everyone that the Chapter would have a safety booth at the States MC April 3rd event and if anyone wanted to help out please do. An ABATE driver safety class was given on March 18th at the Miami Lakes Voc Center.

Products Report: The Products Trustee position is open due to Joel and Kathy moving away. If you are interested in volunteering, please let any of the Executive Board members know. Currently Frank has the products in his garage. If you need anything just give him a call.

Events Coordinator: Frank said the paperwork for the May 29th; our 36th Annual Memorial Day Event is awaiting approval from the State office. The event, if approved, will be held at Mickey's in Pompano Beach. Bob Anz will be cooking for this event. Plus Jimmy Les and Suzanne are planning something special for Memorial Day.

State Representative Report: There was no State meeting this month. The next meeting is April 9th, in Cocoa, FL starting at 2 pm.

Membership Report: T-Man reported for February, we had 13 new members joining, 23 renews, 3 new life members, for a total of 529 active SE Chapter members. He said people used to join because it was safe to ride with us. We need to get back to that. A reminder, when submitting all membership forms **PLEASE** fill them out completely and legible so that we can read it, and send it in a timely manner. Thank you very much for your support and membership to the Southeast Chapter.

Newsletter Editor: Squeezer was present and as of Friday he had not received any articles for April. This month he will meet with Ada and start training her to take over for next year.

Legislative Report: Brad spoke and told us that the Legislature had its last session on March 11th.

The VRU Bill failed. All we had to do was let the legislators know that this was important and it would have passed. When there is a call to action – we need to take action.

Billing and Invoicing: Pixie was not present, but excused - Frank said everyone is up to date. He also mentioned when getting a new ad remember to get the application filled out and get the check. **Please remember to support our advertisers, because they support us.**

Social Director's Report: Patty said we have a beautiful cake. Frank asked if we wanted to move our birthday parties back to our advertiser's locations in lieu of having the party after the chapter meeting. For now, we'll stay put after the meetings, but will ask again next month. T-Man suggested having our birthday parties at the American Legions during their bike nights.

Newsletter Distribution: Frank thanked Poppi for picking up his newsletter route while he was in Daytona. Poppi reported all is going good, and that we might need someone to pick-up Airborne's route – hopefully he will be recovered by then. Poppi also mentioned some places have excess Newsletters left at our distribution locations and to note how many old Newsletters that are picked up so an adjustment can be made for the next delivery.

Quartermaster Report: Bob reported that there is no report.

Photographer's Report: Ada was excused.

Web-Master's Report: Rogue was excused but reported that everything is up and running.

Legal Counsel: Demetrios was not present.

Old Business: There was no old Business to report.

New Business: There was no New Business to report

NCOM CONVENTION HONORS FALLEN RIDERS; INVITES NAMES FOR TRIBUTE

With the 31st Annual NCOM Convention in Atlantic City just weeks away, the National Coalition of Motorcyclists is requesting that MROs, motorcycle clubs, and riding associations submit the names of those members and supporters who have died since May 2015, so that we may honor their memories during the traditional “Ringing of the Bell” tribute to fallen riders during the opening ceremonies. Dedications can be hand-delivered at the Convention to “Doc” Reichenbach, NCOM Chairman of the Board, or e-mailed in advance to Bill Bish at NCOMBish@aol.com.

Attendees are also encouraged to bring an item on behalf of their organization for the Freedom Fund Auction, with proceeds benefiting the motorcyclists’ rights movement nationwide through Getting Our People Elected donations, NCOM Speaker Program, lobbying activities and other pro-motorcycling projects as determined by the NCOM Board of Directors.

The 31st annual NCOM Convention will be held Mother’s Day weekend, May 5-8, 2016 at Harrah’s Resort, located at 777 Harrah’s Blvd in Atlantic City, New Jersey. This annual gathering will draw bikers’ rights activists from across the country to discuss topics of concern to all riders, so reserve your room now for the special NCOM rate of \$109 by calling (888) 516-2215.

Registration fees for the NCOM Convention are \$80 including the Silver Spoke Awards Banquet on Saturday night, or \$45 for the Convention only. All motorcyclists are welcome and encouraged to attend. Meetings, seminars and group discussions will focus on legislative efforts and litigation techniques to benefit our right to ride and Freedom of the Road.

ANTI-PROFILING BILL HEARD IN MINNESOTA

A minority group claims its members are being unfairly profiled and stopped by police, and it’s demanding a bill to prevent it. That group is motorcyclists, and the

legislation, put before Minnesota’s Senate Judiciary Committee by State Senator David Osmek (R-Mound), would require Minnesota’s Board of Peace Officer Standards & Training to develop a statewide policy to eliminate motorcyclist profiling, including methods to identify and avoid it. SF1509 in the Senate, and companion bill HF59 in the House, would also require every law enforcement agency in the state to have “a written anti-motorcycle profiling policy.”

In testimony, several members of Minnesota motorcycle clubs laid out a litany of their own experiences: Officers they believed had pulled them over on trumped-up pretenses questioned them about who they were and why they were in their community and, in some cases, photographed their tattoos & patches. “It’s my constitutional right to be in a Motorcycle Club,” said Jim Jahnke of Rochester, the National V.P. of the Sons of Silence MC.

Frank Ernst of Chanhassen, MN representing ABATE of Minnesota, and also chairman of the National Coalition of Motorcyclists - Legislative Task Force (NCOM-LTF), described an instance in which he said he was pulled over by an officer who claimed he hadn’t seen Ernst’s protective eye wear, which he was wearing, but Ernst didn’t file an official complaint.

Sen. Osmek admitted the bill is based largely on anecdotal evidence, but told the state’s Daily Globe newspaper that “I’m focusing on something that constituents brought to me that they had issue with,” and he urges motorcyclists to file complaints and collect data on their own in order to make a stronger case.

Meanwhile, a motorcycle profiling bill is gaining momentum in Maryland, having passed the state Senate unanimously 47-0 on March 3 and now moves to the House, positioning Maryland to become the second state in the country behind Washington to pass such anti-discrimination legislation.

FEWER AMERICANS GETTING A DRIVER’S LICENSE

It used to be a rite of passage into adulthood, but today fewer and fewer U.S. residents are lining up at their local DMV to get a driver’s license, and new data indicates that all age groups are affected.

Analyzing decades of data from the Federal Highway Administration, a team from the University of Michi-

gan's Transportation Research Institute found that since 2011, the number of U.S. citizens with drivers licenses across all age groups, from 16 to 70, has decreased.

A recent University of Michigan report analyzed decades' worth of Federal Highway Administration records to show how licensure across all age groups has declined in the period stretching from 1983 to 2014.

Last year, nearly 77% of 20- to 24-year-old drivers held a license; in 1983, nearly 92% in that age bracket had one. Four years ago, the number was about 80%. For 16- through 44-year-olds, there has been a continuous decline in the percentage of people with a driver's license.

The news may not be surprising for younger generations, who are more likely to use public transit or a ride-sharing company, or telecommute, but researchers also found a decline in the number of older adults with a driver's license.

Other reports have detected related trends, such as a decrease in the distance driven per person and less travel time overall, but even as the age of driverless cars approaches, a driver's license will continue to be mandatory for years to come.

WHITE HOUSE PUSHES DRIVERLESS CARS

The Obama administration aims to remove hurdles to making autonomous cars more widespread, and the President's fiscal 2017 budget proposes spending \$4 Billion over the next decade to accelerate the integration of driverless cars on U.S. roadways.

The administration's multi-billion dollar proposal, which would require Congressional approval, calls on federal regulators to work with auto makers and others to craft policies and rules regarding autonomous vehicles and their development.

"We are going to do everything we can to advance safe, smart and sustainable transportation innovations," announced Transportation Secretary Anthony Foxx at the Detroit Auto Show, "We are bullish on automated vehicles."

In addition to the new testing programs, Foxx also unveiled ambitious federal guidelines that he says

will get self-driving on the roads quicker -- and more safely -- than ever thought possible. "(These actions) will provide the foundation and the path forward for manufacturers, state officials and consumers to use new technologies and achieve their full safety potential" he said.

Now, NHTSA will seek input from automakers and others as the auto agency tries to wrap its arms around the deployment and operation of fully self-driving cars as the norm, not an anomaly.

In addition, the agency plans to team up with state partners and the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators to develop a model driverless car policy states can implement, hopefully laying the groundwork for a consistent national policy.

CONGRESSIONAL RPM ACT WOULD PROTECT THE SPORT OF RACING

The federal Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is attempting to regulate racing by prohibiting the conversion of street motorcycles and automobiles into competition-only racing vehicles, but newly-introduced legislation in Congress would prevent the EPA from impacting the lives of tens of thousands of armature and professional racers, their support teams and millions of race fans across the country.

Members of both chambers of Congress have introduced bipartisan versions of a bill that would protect the sport of racing by blocking the EPA from over-regulating the industry and ensuring that it remains legal to convert street legal motor vehicles for racing purposes.

The RPM Act (Recognizing the Protection of Motorsports Act of 2016); "A bill to exclude vehicles used solely for competition from certain provisions of the Clean Air Act" H.R.4715, was introduced March 7, 2016 in the House by U.S. Representative Patrick McHenry (R-NC) with 13 bipartisan co-sponsors, while companion measure S.2659 "to reaffirm that the EPA cannot regulate vehicles used solely for competition" was offered in the Senate on March 9 by Senator Richard Burr (R-NC) and three original co-sponsors.

H.R.4715 states, in part: "at the time the Clean Air Act was written, and each time the Clean Air Act has been amended, the intent of Congress has been, and continues to be, that vehicles manufactured for, modified

for, or utilized in organized motorized racing events would not be encompassed by the Clean Air Act's definition of "motor vehicle".

The EPA recently re-opened the proposed regulation for more public comment. The regulation is scheduled for final approval this summer, so the time to act is NOW.

WISCONSIN BILL WOULD RESTRICT ACCESS TO BLACK BOX DATA

A bill that would require an owner's consent to access data in "black boxes" in cars and motorcycles seems more likely than ever before to come up for a vote in January 2017, according to members of ABATE of Wisconsin, a grassroots lobbyist group that deals with motorcycle issues but now finds itself leading the charge in fighting for privacy.

The bill covers not only Event Data Recorders or EDR's but any device that is recording any information or tracking user behavior. Anyone that took the information without consent faces potential fines ranging from \$200 to \$2000 per incident.

The bill says insurance companies would not be able to link the issuance or renewal of a liability policy to whether the vehicle has such a box, or whether the motorist allows the insurer to access or use data it collects.

Currently, the boxes record such data only in the seconds before, during and after a crash. But critics like ABATE, worry about how much more information the devices might collect as they become more sophisticated. ABATE says while the timing of the recordings may be limited now, safe guards need to be in place should that change.

At least 23 other states have passed laws defining who owns EDR data, according to Steve Panten, a spokesman for ABATE of Wisconsin, which supports the bill.

EX-COP SUES OVER MOTORCYCLE NOISE

A former Texas police officer is suing Arkansas officials over motorcycle noise. Rick Holtsclaw, a 31-year veteran of the Houston police department who placed an emphasis on noise enforcement, has sued city officials in Fort Smith and Fayetteville, Arkansas for their failure to enforce federal, state, and local laws regard-

ing motorcycle noise.

Holtsclaw's lawsuit cites the Noise Control Act of 1972 that makes it illegal for motorcycle exhausts to be altered or removed for the purpose of making noise. In addition, the Arkansas muffler statute requires every motor vehicle to be equipped with the quiet factory-installed muffler or a muffler duplicating the specifications of the factory-installed muffler.

Holtsclaw stated that "the law enforcement community in Arkansas has failed to intercede on behalf of the noise-beleaguered citizenry," particularly at rallies "where there are thousands of motorcyclists making illegally loud noise," and is seeking \$1,000,000 (one million) in damages from each municipality.

DRIVER WHO DELIBERATELY ASSAULTED MOTORCYCLISTS STILL IN JAIL

A viral video showing a Texas driver who without provocation intentionally crashed into a motorcyclist last October, causing serious injuries to the rider and his passenger, has been languishing in jail unable to post bail since the incident.

William "Bill" Sam Crum was indicted by a Hood County grand jury on two aggravated assault counts carrying punishment of up to 20 years in prison and a fine up to \$10,000 and is currently being held on \$150,000 bail in Hood County Jail since his arrest October 20, 2015.

While motorcyclists can take comfort knowing that Mr. Crum has been in jail nearly 6 months awaiting trial on criminal charges, because he purposefully crashed into the victims, his auto insurance won't cover any civil judgment due to the intentional act exclusion in every policy.
